If you or your group has a competitive spirit, we invite you to enter in Dalby's multicultural volleyball competition. As a team you will have the chance to highlight your culture and also to share in \$1,000 prize money and have your name on the perpetual trophy for 2017.

1. There will be two divisions – Junior (School Age) and Senior (Juniors may play in the Senior Division)
2. All teams must complete the registration form below and be accepted prior to the event.
3. Entry fees are \$20 per team. Registration forms are to be submitted by 4 **August 2017**.
4. Teams will be required to play from 12:00 pm – 4:00 pm on Saturday 26 August Anderson Park. The draw will be sent out by 18 August 2017.
5. Team members are encouraged to wear cultural dress.
6. Teams will be required to check in at least 20 minutes before the game.
7. Winners in each division will receive \$300, runner-up \$200.
8. All players must be safe and in no way endanger any person or property - Fun and Fair Play at ALL times.
9. Each team is allowed 6 players on the playing field during a game.
10. Games are 20 minutes – 2 x 10 minute halves with a 2 minute half-time break.
11. Please ensure you arrive a few minutes before your game to sign on, warm up and stretch to avoid injuries.
12. Players may substitute at any time during the game as often as they wish as long as this does not cause a break in play. Players being substituted must leave the field prior their replacement entering the field.
13. Teams receive 3 points for a win, 2 for a draw, 1 for a loss and 0 for a forfeit. The competition table is updated online at the conclusion of each round.
14. Have FUN, play safely within the rules and within your own physical capabilities.

MULTICULTURAL VOLLEYBALL COMPETITION

Saturday 26 August 2017

RULES OF PLAY

Rules of play are based on standard volleyball rules, but maybe modified to suit the social nature of the competition, the time available and the facilities used. Dalby Welcoming Community Inc. retains the right to make determinations on issues that fall outside of documented rules and is the final authority in all interpretations and decisions.

SERVING

Play starts with a serve. Each player has two serves (regardless of win or loss of the point) then the serve alternates to the other team. The ball cannot touch the net.

SCORING

Is continuous so that both the serving and receiving team can win the point. The team with the highest score at the end of the timed game is the winner.

TOUCHES

A maximum of 3 touches before the ball passes over the net except in the case of a block, which does not count as a touch. Players may touch the ball with any part of their body during the point only ie. not on the serve.

No player may touch the ball twice in a row except off a block.

NET

Should a player touch the net during play the point is finished and awarded to the opposing team. The ball may be played off the net except from a serve.

ROTATION

When a team gains service, players rotate clockwise one position.

SUBSTITUTES

May be made at the service position when a team is awarded service.

SPIKING

No spiking or blocking off a service. The receiving shot must go up & over the net.

CARRY

No prolonged contact with the ball is allowed - it must not come to rest in the players hands. This includes scooping the ball or holding it temporarily whilst setting it.

BOUNDARIES

If the ball bounces on the line, it is in. Players can run outside their boundary lines to retrieve the ball however it must pass over the net between the poles.
